Scope

The Nordic Supervisor works closely with all departments within the resort and assists in the coordination of programs, events and partnerships with area businesses and community and school groups.

Preferred Experience

The ideal candidate will be proficient in both classic and skate skiing techniques and have a strong history in, and passion for the sport of Nordic skiing. Strong organizational skills, effective communication skills, and some supervisory experience required. Familiarity or experience in the fields of retail, rentals, food and beverage, and/ or Nordic ski programming preferred.
