

Position Overview: PVST Groomer

The PVST Groomer is responsible for grooming the Plain Valley Ski Trails, ensuring they are well-maintained and ready for use. This role plays a vital part in supporting PVST's mission to create a top-tier ski trail system that funds inclusive ski education programs.

Goals and Responsibilities:

- Support PVST's mission by contributing to the maintenance of a top-tier ski trail system through effective grooming practices.
- Groom trails to provide a high-quality skiing experience for users.
- Care for grooming equipment, ensuring it is in optimal condition for efficient operation.
- Maintain the aesthetic and functional quality of the trails by collecting trash, attending to knocked-over signs, and addressing other visual concerns.
- Communicate immediately with the PVST Mechanic regarding any issues with the equipment to ensure timely repairs and minimize downtime.
- Collaborate with the Trails Manager to accomplish additional tasks essential for the successful operation of the ski trail system.
- Be reliable, responsible, and punctual, with the ability to work flexible hours, including early mornings and late evenings as dictated by weather conditions.
- Be physically able to shovel out machinery and lift/move grooming implements when needed.
- Complete the grooming report on the Nordic Pulse app and promptly report any issues or concerns on the trails to the Trails Manager.

Health and Safety Responsibilities:

- Prioritize safety by annually updating safety skills and ensuring that all staff undergo relevant safety training.
- Understand and adhere to established safety procedures, including emergency protocols, to maintain a safe working environment.

Reporting Structure:

PVST Groomers report to and follow directives from the PVST Trails Manager.

Compensation:
